Juan Ignacio Mena is the winemaker and co-owner. The wines at Tinajas del Maule are produced using entirely their own grapes.

<u>Tinajas del Maule</u> does not participate in wine competitions and wine events. However, their wines have received high ratings on Vivino. Tinajas wines stand out on the shelves with eye catching labels.

Carmeneret/Merlot blend, Intense red colour with bright violet tones. On the nose, aromas of caramel, toffee, figs and nuts. On the palate it's juicy and concentrated, especially in the middle mouth. It expresses itself particularly well when paired with spicy and fatty dishes, and game animals like duck <u>Vivino Score 4.1</u>

This wine is a perfectly balanced conversation between Carmenere and Cabernet. The sum is greater than the parts. Cabernet brings structure and longevity, while Carmenere adds spiciness and rich fruit flavors. This wine is deep colored and concentrated. Its bouquet is complex and evolves in the glass. Red and black fruit flavors merge with intriguing spiciness and black pepper aromas. An elegant acidity and full body make it a wine to drink now or keep. Vivino Score 4.1





### Hispalis Blanco - Macabeo

DO: Jumilla - Spain

12 .5 % alcohol

1.3 Grs. of Residual Sugar SKU: 893252

Greenish-white with straw-like tones. It exhibits floral aromas such as jasmine and tropical fruits like pineapple and grapefruit. We discover an excellent balance between its acidity and a gentle sweetness from the alcohol, resulting in a rounded and harmonious wine.



### Hispalis Rosado - Monastrel

DO: Jumilla - Spain

12 .5 % alcohol

2.3 Grs. of Residual Sugar

Attractive, very intense crimson-red color, with subtle blue-violet hues, clear and bright. Fresh and pleasant aroma on the nose. Fruity notes suggesting both acidic and sweet red fruits (raspberries and strawberries), along with other fruits with tropical hints like mango. Hints of fresh herbs. On the palate, it presents a fresh start with lively acidity.





### **Fincas Don Martino**

Don Martino is a family winery with a moto of curiosity, always looking for new places to grow, the best grapes and exploring different types of wines.

Martino counts with <u>Attilio Pagli</u>, one of the most recognized and prestigious Italian oenologists and viticulturists in the world, who has been advising Martino Wines since 2013.

Pagli specializes in indigenous varieties in his country, such as Sangiovese, and is a pioneer of Argentine Malbec. Despite having received more than five perfect scores of 100 points from Robert Parker, he believes that the personality of the Terroir is what inspires his dedication to oenology.

Intense and bright violet tones are observed, aromas of fresh red fruit are perceived on the nose, there are notes reminiscent of violets and slight notes of tobacco and chocolate. The palate has an elegant entrance is fresh, complex, has a good palate and invites you to have second glass.



#### Martino Cabernet Franc

DO: Luján de Cuyo, Mendoza - Argentina

14 .3 % alcohol

Perdriel, Luján de Cuyo, Mendoza. 970 meters above sea level Soil type: Loamy-sandy soil.

The color of this varietal is deep red with deep black tones. Notes of black fruits, spices and red pepper are appreciated on the nose. Its aging in oak makes this varietal more complete on the nose and in the mouth, contributing notes of chocolate and vanilla, resulting in an unctuous, long and balanced wine.



### Martino Pedro Ximénez

DO: Valle de Uco, Mendoza - Argentina

Vintage: 2022

13% alcohol

La Consulta, Valle de Uco, Mendoza. 1100 meters above sea level. Malolactic fermentation: With indigenous yeasts. Aging: 70% vessels - 30% in french oak barrels of first used. It has a soft yellow color with steely and greenish tones. It immediately highlights its aroma of white flowers, in addition to some citrus expressions, such as grapefruit, which the Uco Valley gives us. In the mouth its freshness is distinguished with a balanced acidity and the complexity granted by its 30% fermentation and aging in French oak of first use. It is a distinct, fresh and intense white wine.



Located in San José, Tupungato (Mendoza) at 1300 msnm, it's known as "the stone-roofed winery." The preservation of the wild forest surrounding Bodega Atamisque is unique and is complemented by over 135 hectares of vineyards.

The winery is renowned for its production of high-end wines.



### Serbal Viognier

Pale to medium golden-yellow color, with hints of green at the edges. Intense and aromatic. It bursts with a bouquet of floral and fruity aromas. Ripe stone fruit aromas, such as juicy apricots, peaches, and hints of tropical fruits like pineapple. It offers a delightful combination of flavors, with ripe apricots and peaches dominating the forefront. The wine's fruitiness is balanced by a refreshing acidity. It has a medium to full body, imparting a generous and mouth-filling sensation. The finish is long and satisfying. Pairs exceptionally well with a variety of dishes, including spicy Asian cuisine, seafood, and creamy cheeses.



### Serbal Pinot Noir

Ruby red color. It presents a bouquet of ripe strawberries, red cherries, and raspberries. There's also a subtle hint of floral notes, with rose petals and violet undertones. On the palate, it is harmonious and balanced. The red fruit notes detected on the nose translate seamlessly to the taste, with juicy strawberry and cherry flavors. There's a gentle acidity that provides freshness and vitality to the wine, making it crisp and lively. Light body with silky-smooth tannins. The tannins are well-integrated and supple, contributing to a velvety mouthfeel that enhances the overall elegance of the wine. It's a wine that pairs wonderfully with a variety of dishes, from grilled salmon to roasted duck, and it's equally enjoyable on its own as a reflection of the region's winemaking expertise.
